State House and Senate To Consider Beach Grooming Bill

BAY CITY, Michigan – February 21, 2003 – Save Our Shoreline announces today the introduction of House Bill #4257, which clarifies the rights of owners along Michigan's Great Lakes shoreline to conduct leveling of sand and beach grooming up to the first four inches of soil. The House Bill was introduced by Representative Brian Palmer. Cosponsors include Reps. Palmer, Sheltrown, Meyer, Elkins, Brandenburg, Acciavatti and Hummel. A similar bill is expected to be introduced in the Senate within the next week.
