Save Our Shoreline Contributes Sand for Pinconning Park

BAY CITY, Michigan – July 25, 2006

Save Our Shoreline announces that it has donated \$500 for the purchase of sand to help restore the beach at Pinconning Park. Placement of the sand is part of an overall beach restoration project which has been ongoing since spring.

“Our Mission Statement calls for the preservation of both private and public beaches,” said Ernie Krygier, SOS President. “This project, like our projects at the Bay City State Recreation Area, and our support of beachgrooming permits at such places as Sleeper State Park and other beaches in Caseville, demonstrates our commitment to public beaches in accordance with our Bylaws,” said Krygier. Earlier this year, the organization had donated \$5,000, raised in cooperation with area 7-Eleven stores, for floating docks at the newly restored Bay City State Recreation Area beach.
